²The deposited material was added to a Luria-Burtani (LB) soft agar overlay (0.5%) supplemented with 10 mM MgSO₄ containing the phage host, *Pseudomonas aeruginosa*, strain Pa1400. The soft agar overlay was added to an LB agar kolle supplemented with 10 mM MgSO₄ and incubated 24 hours at 30°C in an aerobic atmosphere. After two additional passages under the above conditions, the bacteriophage were harvested to produce this lot.

³Lysis was observed on the soft agar overlay after 24 hours at 30°C in an aerobic atmosphere.
