**Provided:** 0.5 mg in 1 ml. mAb purified from tissue culture supernatant and supplied in PBS pH 7.2 with 0.05% sodium azide

**Host Site:** Balb/c x NS-1.

**Special Characteristics:** Raised against a recombinant FIV (Petaluma) integrase protein. The epitope has not been mapped. Recognizes integrase in WB, IPT, and ELISA. Does not recognize FeLV, feline herpes virus type 1, feline coronavirus, or feline calicivirus.

**Recommended Storage:** Keep at 4°C for short term storage and -80°C for long term storage. Avoid freeze-thaw cycles as reagent degradation may result.
