Provided: 26 vials, 1.0 mg each, lyophilized.

Solubility: See attached table. Peptides that are difficult to solubilize can almost always be

dissolved in DMSO. Once a peptide is in solution, the DMSO can be slowly diluted with aqueous medium. Care must be taken to ensure that the peptide does not begin to

precipitate out of solution.

Please note: Cys and Met containing peptide sequences are highly unstable when stored in DMSO for prolonged periods of time; peptide decay is often observed within days to weeks. If DMSO is required, we recommend freshly-prepared working solutions from freeze dried aliquots of these

peptides, and prepared pools.

Series of peptides comprising the SIVmac239 Vpx region. Most of the peptides are 15 amino acids in length, with 11-amino acid overlaps between sequential peptides. Most Characteristics:

peptides are >80% pure.
